2020 – woman the hunter, man the househusband

A new report on life in 2020 was published yesterday. This report predicts (vorhersagen) big changes, not just in technology but also changes in the way we live. These are some of the predictions for work and family life.

Family life: One in five fathers will be househusbands, while mothers go out to work. People will live near other people who have the same interests as them, for example in golf villages. There will often be three generations living in the same house, e.g. grandparents, parents and children. People will live until their mid-eighties, but women will still live a bit longer than men.

Work and study: One in five school classes will be on-line via the Internet. Pupils (Schüler) will also often have video classes with a 'superteacher' from another city or country. Most workers will only have short-term contracts (Arbeitsvertrag). They will have to learn to do lots of different jobs because they will change jobs often. Most people will work a twenty-five hour week. This will usually mean working five hours a day, although some people may work three eight-hour days and have four days off.
